

Kindergarten Guidance I-Can Statements

I can...

Academic

1. show that I feel good about my learning and take pride in my work.
2. tell when and how to ask for help.
3. take responsibility for what I do and say.
4. begin to use skills to help me be an independent learner.
5. begin to explain how my work in my classroom helps me do well in school.
6. tell how getting along and working hard will help me at school and in my community.



Career

1. tell what I'm interested in and what I do well.
2. show that I have a positive attitude about my learning and my work.
3. do my personal best and show responsibility at school.

Personal / Social

1. tell why I am an important and unique person.
2. explain to others what I think and feel is important.
3. respect how our families and cultural differences make us special.
4. tell how the choices that I make can cause happy or sad feelings in myself and others.
5. begin to identify more than one way to solve a problem.
6. identify helpful ways to deal with problems.
7. demonstrate where, when and how to find help for solving problems and making decisions.
8. explain the differences between appropriate and inappropriate touches.
9. explain that everyone needs to have their own personal space.
