

SCRIP 2011-2012

Hello and welcome to the 2011-2012 school year. I would like to introduce myself to you. My name is Susan Cano and I'm in charge of the SCRIP program here at Coolidge. For those of you not familiar with SCRIP, it is basically fundraising through everyday shopping and it is a very easy way to generate a lot of money for our school! Last year we raised \$5500 for the PTA with SCRIP.

What is SCRIP and how does it work?

SCRIP is a program where you buy gift cards for everyday purchases such as gas, groceries, or eating out. There is NO EXTRA COST. When you purchase a \$10 card, you receive a \$10 card. How it works is that Coolidge purchases these cards at a discount from the retailers.

Example- Hawkeye Convenience sells us a \$50 gift card for \$47.50

You buy the gift card for \$50 to use

The difference (\$2.50) goes to Coolidge PTA.

EVERYBODY WINS

Can SCRIP really make a difference?

You bet it can. Take a look...

What if 100 Coolidge families purchased just gas each month using SCRIP for 1 year?

100 families buying gas

X\$100 in gas per month

X 12 months

X 5% profit (i.e. Hawkeye card)

\$6000 in profit for our school!!

Buying SCRIP is SO easy!!

1. Order forms are emailed, can be printed from our website, or placed online.
2. Send your SCRIP order form or online summary and payment to school with your child or drop them off in the office.
3. Orders are placed just about every other Monday (calendar is on website)
4. Your order will be filled and sent home with your child that Friday (or you can pick it up at school if you prefer).
5. We always keep many vendors on hand that are available for same day ordering and someone is usually outside the office on **Friday After Class (FAC)** with inventory on hand for you to buy directly.
